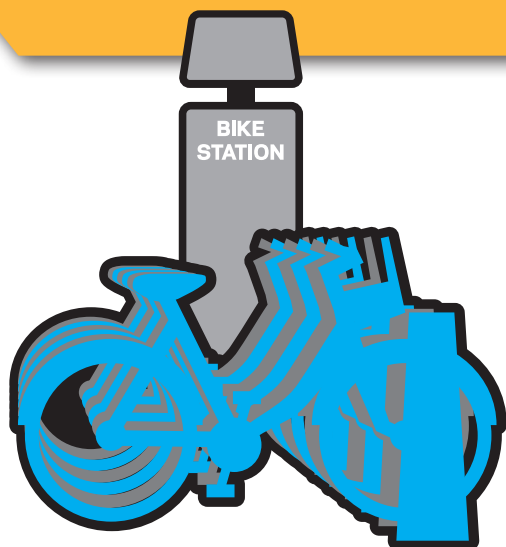

What is Bike Share?



Bike share is a network of thousands of bicycles available at self-service docking stations around the city.

How It Works

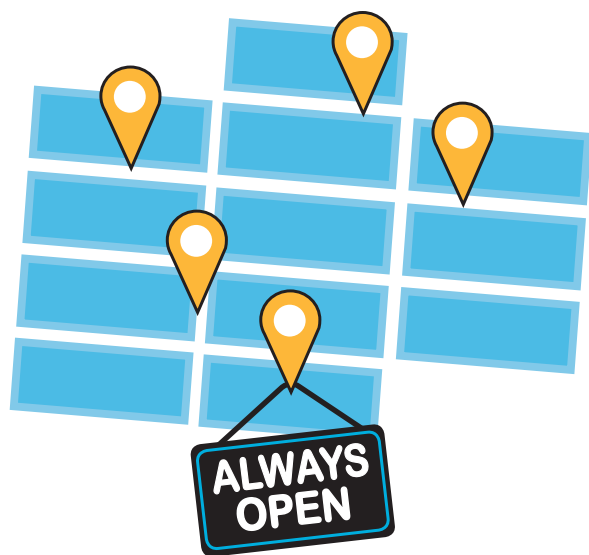
Buy a membership, take out a bike, ride it, and drop it off at any docking station in the city. It's a great new option for quick trips that can make getting around New York a little easier.

Cost

Bike share membership in New York City will be very affordable—an annual membership will cost of less than one unlimited monthly MetroCard.

Availability

The system will offer 10,000 bikes and over 600 stations, available 24/7, 365 days a year beginning in the summer of 2012!
